Driving directions (if you need them):

## From the south:

I-77 North to Beckley, WV, take exit 48 to US 19 north. Drive 21.5 miles north to Fayetteville. Turn left at the light onto WV State Route 16. Your landmark is the Tudor's Biscuit World on the right at the junction. If you miss the turn to SR 16 and stay on US 19, you'll pass over the New River Gorge Bridge, and you'll need to turn back.

Drive about six miles on SR 16 to Beckwith (a couple of churches and a convenience store, now closed). Look for the Whirl signs and turn left onto County Road 8 (Fayette County Park Road). At the big wooden Fayette County Park sign, take the right fork up a slight rise to the camp entrance. After passing the camp barrier, turn right and take the single-lane road up the hill to the dance hall and cabins.

## From the east:

I-64 East to exit 156 Sam Black Church to US Route 19. Follow signs for US 19 South to Fayetteville. Just before Fayetteville, cross the New River Gorge bridge and at the first stoplight, turn RIGHT onto Route 16 North. Drive about six miles on SR 16 to Beckwith (a couple of churches and a convenience store, now closed). Look for the Whirl signs and turn left onto County Road 8 (Fayette County Park Road). At the big wooden Fayette County Park sign, take the right fork up a slight rise to the camp entrance. After passing the camp barrier, turn right and take the single-lane road up the hill to the dance hall and cabins.

## From the north:

I-79 South, take exit 57 to US 19 south. Drive 51 miles to junction with SR 16 at Fayetteville (soon after crossing New River Gorge Bridge). Turn right and follow directions above.

## From the west:

Traveling through Charleston, WV, there are two routes with similar travel times but different type roads. Following I-77 South you can either stay on I-77 which becomes WV Turnpike with 1 cash toll of \$4.25 (EZ Pass transponders accepted) OR take the windy US Route 60 East and save 10 minutes.

If you take the **WV Turnpike**, take Exit 60 Mossy/Oak Hill and follow signs to Oak Hill and US Highway 19 North. US 19 North takes you to Fayetteville where you turn LEFT onto State Route 16. (This is at a stoplight and if you look right you'll see a Tudor's Biscuit World.) Drive about six miles on SR 16 to Beckwith (a couple of churches and a convenience store, now closed). Look for the Whirl signs and turn left onto County Road 8 (Fayette County Park Road). At the big wooden Fayette County Park sign, take the right fork up a slight rise to the camp entrance. After passing the camp barrier, turn right and take the single-lane road up the hill to the dance hall and cabins. Taking **Route 60 "Midland Trail"** you can leave I-77 at several points for US Route 60 East. Last chance is the Chelyan exit, then cross the Kanawha River and go right, following signs for US Route 60 East and travel 28.2 miles to Chimney Corner. Bear RIGHT to stay on Route 16--a very scenic 5 miles to cross the New River and ascend the hill to Beckwith and the turnoff to camp. Watch for signs to turn RIGHT onto County Road 8 (Fayette County Park Road). At the big wooden Fayette County Park sign, take the right fork up a slight rise to the camp entrance. After passing the camp barrier, turn right and take the single-lane road up the hill to the dance hall and cabins.
